<sup>30</sup> I **went by** the field of the **SLOTHFUL**,  
and by the vineyard of the **MAN VOID OF UNDERSTANDING**;  
<sup>31</sup> and lo,

It was **ALL GROWN OVER** with thorns,  
and **NETTLES** had covered the face thereof, and  
its stone wall thereof was **BROKEN DOWN**.

<sup>32</sup> Then I **saw**, and **considered** it well:  
I **looked** upon it, and **received instruction**.

<sup>33</sup> "Yet A little **SLEEP**,  
A little **SLUMBER**,  
A little **FOLDING OF THE HANDS TO SLEEP**:"

<sup>34</sup> So shalt thy **POVERTY** come as one that **TRAVELLETH**;
