

Psalm 110

¹ God the Father said to His Son, Jesus Christ the LORD¹,

“Son,

Sit down on the right side on My throne of heaven. Stay there until I send You to conquer all of Your enemies. Then, after You have defeated them, You will put Your feet upon their necks as a sign of victory and sovereignty. ² Now, how will I accomplish this task through You? First, I will establish Your dominion in Jerusalem, and then I will extend it in all directions from there. At that time I will say to You,

‘Go, rule and reign over all Your enemies and all those who are hostile toward you. Do it from a location right in the middle of all Your enemies.

³ In the day when You come to your rightful place of power, all of Your followers will volunteer to be of service to you. They will present themselves to You of their own free own will and not of compulsion. They will be clothed in sacred glory like Adam when You created him, and they will be as refreshing to You as the dew of the morning.’

⁴ Son, I have sworn with an oath that You are and always will be a priest after the order of the Old Testament priest Melchizedek, and You know very well that I will not change my mind about the matter. ⁵ You are at My right hand, and from there You will shatter both the kings of the earth and their kingdoms in the day when You pour out Your wrath against the world. ⁶ Then You will judge the nations and find them guilty of all sorts of sins and atrocities. You will slaughter the guilty and fill the lands with their corpses, and You will shatter all of the authorities of all of the nations, effectively removing them from power. ⁷ You will drink the blood of the slain as You pour out Your rage like a flash flood rushing down a mountain canyon devastating everything in its path. This will happen so fast that Your opponents will not have time to react, let alone put up a unified resistance. As a result, You will not experience any appreciable opposition, and so You will secure Your throne and dominion forever. Son, You have My word on it. All of this will happen exactly as I have said.”
