<sup>1</sup> Everyone, listen to me! It is so pleasant and so refreshing when those who belong to Jesus Christ<sup>1</sup> live, work, and play together in unity. <sup>2</sup> The experience of dwelling together in unity is every bit as good and pleasant as when Aaron was anointed chief priest when olive oil was poured on his head. It saturated his head, ran down his face, ran through his beard, and dripped onto the hem of his robe. In essence, he was anointed from head to foot. <sup>3</sup> Dwelling together in unity is also as delightful and refreshing as the dew that comes down from the slopes of Mount Hermon and settles on the hills around Jerusalem. Without doubt, those who dwell together in unity will experience the pleasantness of real life that flows through them from head to foot, and their lives will be as delightful and refreshing as when the dew settles on the ground to cool and water it.
