He offers the free gift of salvation to everyone who wants to be set free from the prison of sin. ⁸ He gives blind men the ability to see and heals those are bowed down with physical infirmities. He loves people who live in a good and godly manner, ⁹ protects the stranger, and helps the orphan and widow in their need. All the while Christ is opposed to the conduct of wicked people and sees that their evil plans are turned upside down resulting in ruin.
