⁵ I wait silently for my God to rescue me because He is my only hope. ⁶ His name is the only place I can go to find real defense and salvation. I have complete confidence in Him, and my confidence will not be shaken. ⁷ I can rest knowing that He will secure my salvation and my eternal future. Not only that, but He will be the secure place from which I can gain strength. ⁸ I encourage all of you who are reading this to trust in the LORD at all times like I have. Pour out your heart to Him in prayer, and you will find him to be your refuge too.

Folks, stop what you are doing and ponder the truths I have shared with you. Trust the LORD, and you will understand.

⁹ It is useless to trust men or women to do for you what only God can do. Consider this: seeking help from men or women who are unimportant is a useless and empty venture, and seeking help from men or women who are supposedly important is a delusion. When you weigh them in the balances there is no substance to either of them. They are lighter than a breath. ¹⁰ It is also useless to oppress others or resort to robbery or extortion in order to gain wealth or power. Don't make gaining riches your heart's desire because it won't be long before those riches vanish, and you certainly can't take them with you to the grave.

¹¹ I have heard God say more than once that power belongs to Him alone and that He is the source of tender love and kindness. He is the One who rewards men according to their works. He will reward those who live good and godly with good things, and He will reward those who live a sinful lifestyle with the punishment they deserve.
